heads into his 16th year as founder and director of the Anderson Soccer Camps. Coach Fridley has been the head coach at Anderson University with the men for 16 years and he starts his 9th year with the women. Coach Fridley graduated from Anderson University with a degree in business management and a minor in Christian Ministry. He worked for Marriott Corporation before turning to AU to coach full time in 2002. Coach Fridley was a four year starter in goal for the Ravens. He continues to hold many of the University’s keeper records. Coach Fridley is nationally licensed by the NSCAA and the USSF. His Anderson men’s team has won 2 conference championships and 2 Post Season tournament championships. Fridley’s men’s program has been named NSCAA National Academic Team for 13 straight years keeping over a 3.0 GPA and won the NSCAA Team Ethics awards for the 2nd time this year. The women have won the Academic Award 11 straight years, as well as being named National Team Ethics Award for 10 straight years.

Coach Fridley is serving his 4th term on the NCAA national tournament selection committee for the Men. Coach Fridley currently helps out Hoosier FC youth soccer club as the DOC and currently coach’s the U-15 Boys White Team. He has coached 21 years of youth travel soccer. Coach Fridley is from Milwaukee, Wisconsin where he played for Wauwatosa East H.S. and the Milwaukee Kickers program. He resides in Anderson with his wife Wendy and their five children Aaron, Austin, Casey, Madison, and Mason.
