Scott Fridley, Camp Director —heads into his 15th year as founder and director of the Anderson Soccer Camps. Coach Fridley has been the head coach at Anderson University with the men for 15 years and he starts his 9th year with the women. Coach Fridley graduated from Anderson University with a degree in business management and a minor in Christian Ministry. He worked for Marriott Corp. as a manager, before turning to AU to coach full time. Coach Fridley was a four year starter in goal for the Ravens. He continues to hold many of the University's keeper records. Coach Fridley is nationally licensed by the NSCAA and the USSF. His men's team has won 2 conference championships (2000, 2004). Fridley's men's program has been named NSCAA National Academic Team for 12 straight years keeping over a 3.0 GPA. The women have won the Academic Award 11 straight years, as well as being named National Team Ethics Award winners again, for the 2008 campaign. Coach Fridley is serving his 4th term on the NCAA national tournament selection committee. He has also coached 21 years of youth soccer. Coach Fridley is from Milwaukee, Wisconsin where he played for Wauwatosa East H.S. and the Milwaukee Kickers program. He resides in Anderson with his wife Wendy and their five children Aaron, Austin, Casey, Madison, and Mason.

Brad Crumbacher, Assistant Director —returns for his 14th year with the Anderson Soccer Camps. Coach Brad was a three-year starter at forward for Anderson University where he still holds many of the scoring records, including goals in a season with 19. Coach Brad was also the assistant coach at Anderson University for five years. He is licensed through the NSCAA and the USSF, Brad has coached youth travel for seven years. He is from Xenia, Ohio where he played high school and club ball. He currently coaches the Girls Soccer Team at Heath High School in Heath, Ohio. Coach Brad lives in Columbus, Ohio with his wife Jill and daughters Anna and Abby.

Ryan Bennison, Camp Staff—returns to the Anderson Soccer Camp staff for a 2nd year after 5 years as a counselor. Coach Ryan is licensed through the NSCAA. He was a four-year starter at Anderson University where he was the captain and player of the year in the conference in 2000.

He has coached at the college and high school level. Before returning to Anderson University last fall as the men's assistant coach, Coach Ryan coached at Ruston high school for 3 years in Louisiana. He is from Lafayette, Indiana where he played at Harrison High school and played club ball as well. Ryan currently lives in Anderson with his wife Rachel.

Chris Spolyar, Camp Staff—returns for his 3rd year on staff. Chris has been the Highland High School men's coach for the past 10 years. He played in goal for two years for Anderson University back in the 90's. Chris currently lives in Anderson, with his wife Stacy and two children, Conner & Carter, where is a National City Bank branch manager.

David Ray, Camp Staff—returns to the staff for a 2nd year after four years as a counselor. Coach Ray played four years at Anderson University and has coached five years of youth soccer. He is licensed through the NSCAA and USSF. Coach Ray grew up in Anderson, IN where he played with the AASA Blitz and Anderson High School. He now resides in California with his wife, Heather.

Bobby Holden, Goalkeeping Trainer—returns to the staff for the 2nd year as the goalkeeping instructor and 4th year overall. He was a four year letterman at Anderson University as a goalkeeper. Coach Bobby played at Greenfield Central High and club for the Greenfield Strikers. He also played 1 year for the Indiana Select Amateur team. Coach Bobby does individual, team, and club goalkeeping instruction. He trains many young keepers in central Indiana. Coach Bobby resides in Anderson.
